**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS CODE OF  
ORDINANCES CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3-12,  
LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATION AND  
SECTION 3-26, PROHIBITED CONDUCT.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Village, as a municipal corporation, has a duty to regulate the purchase, sale and serving of alcoholic beverages to the public for the protection of the public, health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt this ordinance amending the Alcoholic Liquor Control Ordinance of the Village of Vernon Hills pursuant to its duty to regulate the purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages within the Village of Vernon Hills;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.** That Chapter 3, section 3-12(8), "License Classification and Fees" of the Vernon Hills Alcoholic Liquor Control Code be amended to read as follows:

3-12(8) *Class "H" license:* A class "H" license shall authorize the service or sale of alcoholic liquor in conjunction with the catering of food for parties, weddings and special events at a permanent facility designed for such events and not open as a regular restaurant or bar. Class "H" licenses shall be subject to the following conditions and limitations:

- a. Not more than one (1) permanent catering licenses shall be issued to any one establishment at any time in the village.
- b. All requirements of the Vernon Hills Liquor Code shall be met including provisions of insurance and BASSET certification.
- c. The facility shall be required to obtain the Catering License.

**SECTION II.** That Chapter 3, section 3-12(10), "License Classification and Fees" of the Vernon Hills Alcoholic Liquor Control Code is hereby amended by deleting Class "J" Liquor license in its entirety.

**SECTION III.** That Chapter 3, section 3-26, "Prohibited Conduct" of the Vernon Hills Alcoholic Liquor Control Code is amended by addition of new paragraph, (f), as follows:

3-26 (f) *Prohibited Conduct*: No person shall consume or be in possession of any alcoholic liquor on licensed premises other than that alcoholic liquor sold and dispensed by the licensee. The licensee or his/her agent shall have the authority to order the immediate removal of any alcoholic liquor carried onto licensed premises in violation of this section.

**SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY.** In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

**SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION VII. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet for in the manner provided by law.


**SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER.** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2009-007.


