ORDINANCE 2009-049

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN
VILLAGE PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS AND
PROVIDING FOR THE SALE BY PUBLIC OR
INTERNET AUCTION, DONATION OR
SCRAP DISPOSAL IF NOT SOLD IN 60
DAYS.**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to sell such surplus property by public or internet auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property of the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely:

EIGHT (8) METRA PARKING LOT METAL FARE COLLECTION BOXES

SECTION II. The said surplus equipment is no longer in usable condition for the Village of Vernon Hill. The said surplus property is to be sold through an internet auction and if not sold within 60 days they will be salvage and sold for metal recycling.

SECTION III. The said surplus property shall be withdrawn from a sale at the public or internet auction unless the following minimum sum of \$100 should be bid for said property.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances of parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2009-049.




