**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS CODE  
OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 3,  
SECTIONS 3-12, LIQUOR LICENSE  
CLASSIFICATION AND SECTION 25,  
SECTION 25-3, FEES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Village, as a municipal corporation, has a duty to regulate the purchase, sale and serving of alcoholic beverages to the public for the protection of the public, health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt this ordinance amending the Liquor Control Ordinance of the Village of Vernon Hills pursuant to its duty to regulate the purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages within the Village of Vernon Hills;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.** That Chapter 3 Section 3-12 of the Village of Vernon Hills Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by addition of a new section, 3-12(10) creating Liquor License Classification "K" to read as follows:

*3-12(11) Class "K" License:* A class "K" license shall authorize the sale of beer and wine only for consumption on the premises as an incidental part of a Day Spa. Class "K" licenses shall be subject to the following conditions and limitations.

1. The sale of beer, wine on the premises shall be permitted only in connection with a Full Service Day Spa. For the purpose of these requirements, " Full Service Day Spa" is a business establishment, having a minimum gross floor area of 4000 square feet, that offer multiple personal care services which include hair treatments, massages, deep muscle body treatments, Body packs & wraps, exfoliation, waxing, aromatherapy and facial's. Barber shops and beauty salons that offer limited services such as hair and nail treatments shall not be considered a Full Service Day Spa.
2. The sale of beer and wine intended for consumption on the premises shall be limited to individual servings of beer and wine as part of a spa package and shall be served in accordance with section 3-37 of the Liquor and License Code. No more than two servings per customer shall be permitted per calendar day.
3. Consumption of beer, wine on the premises shall not be permitted in the message rooms or locker rooms.
4. It is intended that the service of beer and wine is merely an adjunct to the operation of a Day Spa and that the facility shall not be advertised or otherwise held out to be a drinking establishment.

5. Hours for the sale and/or consumption of beer and wine, shall be in accordance with Section 3-23 of the Liquor and License Code, but in no case shall the sale or consumption of beer & wine take place outside of the normal business hours of the Day Spa.
6. Not more than one (1) class "K" licenses shall be issued at any one time in the Village.

**SECTION II.** That Chapter 25 Section 25-3 of the Village of Vernon Hills Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by addition of the following fee for a Class "K" Liquor License to read as follows:

*25-3. Fee required:* Class "J" Liquor License fees shall be \$300.00 for new license applications and \$1,000.00 for the annual license fee.

**SECTION III. SEVERABILITY.** In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

**SECTION IV. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION VI. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


**SECTION VI. ORDINANCE NUMBER.** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2011-018.
