**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
CERTAIN VILLAGE EQUIPMENT AS
SURPLUS AND HAVING LITTLE OR
NO VALUE TO DISPOSE OF IN AN
APPROPRIATE MANNER**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exists certain surplus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of such surplus equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION I. The following equipment has little or no value with some items condition as unknown and declared to be surplus namely:

Item 1: 42 inch monitor, ViewSonic CD4200, Model VS1177, Serial: QNN071900202.

Item 2: DVR Model dmr42dvd, serial: AJ8J00296.

SECTION II. The said surplus equipment is to be disposed of in an appropriate manner with an individual value of less than \$10.

SECTION III. The said surplus equipment is no longer usable as they are broken or in unusable condition for the Village of Vernon Hills with a value of less than \$10.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications that are severable, the valid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2014-045


