

## RESOLUTION 2016-092

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF A CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT TO RESURFACE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNICATION CENTER PARKING LOTS WITH A LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$74,700

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees desire to maintain the Village's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees approved the FY2016-17 budget of \$85,000 to cover the costs associated with resurfacing the parking lots at the Police Department and Communication Center buildings which have not been resurfaced in over 20 years; and

WHEREAS, staff received three (3) proposals for said work from J&J Pavement Repairs, Inc. (\$100,053), Rabine Paving (\$93,352.87); and A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. (\$74,631.90); with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. submitting the lowest proposal of \$74,631.90; and

WHEREAS, A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. has performed work for the Village in the past, and is currently the contractor overseeing the Village's 2016 Road Rehabilitation Project; and staff feels they are adequate to do the work; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$10,368.10 will be available within the Street Maintenance account (0209059-550050) for any additional work found to be necessary or advantageous to the Village via a resolution amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Village Manager is authorized to execute a contract agreement with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. for the resurfacing of the parking lots at the Police Department and Communication Center buildings in the amount of \$74,631.90; and

THAT, the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$74,700 for said work.


