

**MINUTES OF THE

LIQUOR AND LICENSE COMMISSION HEARING
MARCH 21, 2023**

VM Timony called the Liquor and License Commission Hearing to order at 7:02 p.m.

2. VERNON HILLS PARK DISTRICT, 635 ASPEN DRIVE REQUEST A CLASS “G” LIQUOR LICENSE FOR 2023

The request from the Park District is to allow alcohol service at the following five (5) events:

May 4, 2023	Pub Trivia Night
May 20, 2023	Craft Beer Tasting Event (Century Park South, Sullivan Center as rain location)
July 15, 2023	Wine Tasting (Vernon Hills Days)
July 21, 2023	Comedy Night (Family Aquatic Center)
August 18-19, 2023	Little Bear Ribfest (Century Park)

The Park District is also requesting a waiver of the liquor license fee and the Ribfest tent permit fee. If the Liquor Control Commission agree with the request, Staff recommends that a resolution documenting the terms of the 2023 Class G license be prepared for the next Omnibus agenda.

Motion by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt, second by Deputy Commissioner Oppenheim to have staff prepare a resolution to be brought to the next Village Board meeting, granting a class "G" liquor license documenting these terms.
