**2. DRAMHAMMER AUCTIONS, LLC., 50 LAKEVIEW PARKWAY UNIT 108, REQUEST
FOR A CLASS “L” LIQUOR LICENSE**

DCD Jennings detailed Dramhammer Auctions’ liquor license request for a Class L liquor license. Dramhammer Auctions has requested an amendment to the Class L license regulations to accommodate their business model. The online sale license (Class L) is currently limited to wine sales and would not allow the business to operate as proposed. The modifications to the Class L license regulations are to allow for the sale of additional types of alcoholic beverages, include a reference to the State’s auction license requirements and allow customers to pick up items that have been purchased online. The business estimates that 10% of the buyers would be local and prefer this option over shipping.


Motion by Deputy Commissioner Oppenheim, second by Deputy Commissioner Marquardt to adjourn the Liquor and License Commission Hearing.
