

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS  
RESOLUTION 2024-019**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF KEVIN TIMONY AS THE  
PRINCIPAL DESIGNEE AND PATRICK L. KREIS AS THE ALTERNATE DESIGNEE  
OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS TO LAKECOMM**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills (the “Village”); The County of Lake, an Illinois body politic and corporate; the Village of Fox Lake, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Gurnee, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Hainesville, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Libertyville, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Mundelein, an Illinois municipal corporation; the City of North Chicago, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Round Lake, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Round Lake Beach, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Round Lake Heights, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Round Lake Park, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Vernon Hills, an Illinois municipal corporation; the Village of Winthrop Harbor, an Illinois municipal corporation; and the City of Zion, are all units of local government, organized pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, via separate resolution, the Village and these further municipalities have agreed to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to establish LakeComm as a new, joint governance, consolidated public safety access point (“PSAP”) for the residents of Lake County, including those residing in the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to that IGA, the Village is required to appoint a principal and alternate designee to LakeComm, to represent the Village by participating in board meetings and other official duties of the member municipalities of LakeComm; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President desires to appoint Village Manager, Kevin Timony as the Village’s principal designee to LakeComm, and Chief of Police, Patrick L. Kreis as the alternate designee to LakeComm, and the Board of Trustees find that it is in the best interests of the Village to approve the appointment of these two individuals to serve in their respective capacities.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:**

**SECTION 1: Incorporation.** Each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2: Appointment and Approval of Appointment.** The Village President hereby appoints Kevin Timony as the Village’s principal designee to LakeComm, and Patrick L. Kreis as the alternate designee to LakeComm, and the Board of Trustees approve these appointments.

**SECTION 3: Administration of Oath and Execution of Documents.** The Village President and Board of Trustees also authorize and direct the Village Clerk, or his designee, to administer an oath of office to Kevin Timony and Patrick L. Kreis as required by State law, and the President

and the Village Clerk, or their designees, are authorized and directed to execute and deliver all other instruments and documents and pay all Board-authorized costs that are necessary to fulfill the Village's obligations under this Resolution.

**SECTION 4: Conflicts.** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

**SECTION 5: Severability.** Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Resolution is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**SECTION 6: Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in the manner required by law.


