

RESOLUTION 2011-164

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SIX (6)
LAPTOP COMPUTERS FOR PATROL VEHICLES
FROM CDS OFFICE TECHNOLOGIES
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000**

Whereas, the Police Department utilizes laptop computers in patrol squads for the purpose of receiving calls for assistance through CAD (computer-aided dispatch), recording interactions via in-squad video cameras, and completing reports with Field Reporting (also known as electronic report writing); and

Whereas, last year, no laptops were purchased due to the state of the economy. In 2012, the Village will be taking possession of three (3) new vehicles requiring computers. The three (3) other computers will be cycled in to replace the oldest units in the squad fleet, which are nearing their end of life expectancy, and approaching five (5) years of age; and

Whereas, all purchases and contracts over \$20,000 require Board of Trustees approval; and

Whereas, this purchase meets the Village bidding requirements because CDS Office Technologies is the holder of the State of Illinois master contract and is capable of providing these computers.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD
OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

That the Vernon Hills ETSB Budget (08-33133-580040) has been created as a special account for this item and that the Village Manager is authorized to direct the Police Department to purchase the necessary equipment, not to exceed \$25,000.




