

## **Road Rehabilitation tentative work for the week of May 12th:**

Phase 1 of the 2025 Road Rehabilitation will continue In the Centennial Crossing subdivision. Residents with removals and replacements.

Residents can expect some alley closures at one end of the homes that access the alleys so that the sidewalk and curb work can be completed at one time. Once the concrete has cured sufficiently to be driven on our contractor will commence work on the other end with a closure.

**MOTORIST MAY EXPERIENCE TEMPORARY DELAYS AND POSSIBLE RE-ROUTING OF TRAFFIC DURING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. PLEASE PLAN AHEAD AND ACCORDINGLY WHEN TRAVELING THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION ZONES.**

Locations where removals are planned and may occur at your driveway, the contractor will place a notice at your front door or garage door the day before the removal is to occur. Please have your vehicles moved to the street by 7:00 am the day of removal. Weather may delay the work for that day, but will occur the following day.

Residents have been given permission to park on the street overnight if you are unable to access your driveway, we have notified the Police Department not to enforce the overnight parking restrictions for **Phase 1 only**.

Residents and guest are asked to not park in the locations where barricades have been placed, not blocking driveways, near hydrants and at corners where prohibited by law.

Please refrain from driving on the new concrete until the barricades have been removed (approximately 3 days) by the contractor.

As a reminder, trash and recycle bins are **not** to be placed in the street and should be placed at the end of your driveway apron.
