

## RESOLUTION 2010-090

### **A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO OPERATE AN OUTDOOR MERCHANDISE DISPLAY AND SALES ESTABLISHMENT FOR THE HOME DEPOT LOCATED AT 493 NORTH MILWAUKEE AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, Heather Weingart, representing The Home Dept located at 493 North Milwaukee Avenue has submitted an outdoor establishment permit application and plan for authorization to display and sell merchandise outdoors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, on August 15, 2000, approved Ordinance 2000-61 requiring business owners to seek approval from the Board of Trustees prior to operating an Outdoor Establishment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, having reviewed and considered The Home Depot outdoor establishment permit application and plan at the Committee of the Whole meeting on June 2, 2010, found that the application and plan sufficiently comply with the operational requirements and standards of Ordinance 2000-61 and which, in its judgment, would justify it in recommending approval of an outdoor establishment permit; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, that the Village of Vernon Hills will allow The Home Depot to operate an outdoor merchandise display and sales establishment, conditioned upon:

1. The Merchandise and Display area shall be in accordance with the application and site plan, dated May 26, 2010.
2. Merchandise shall be limited to the outdoor display of seasonal landscaping such as plants, trees, flowers, shrubs and similar live goods. Mulch, Stone, brick pavers, tools, equipment and similar dry goods shall not be permitted,
3. Seasonal merchandise may be displayed until July 7, 2010. The Home Depot must seek approval from the Village Board on a yearly basis.
4. Tents, green houses and similar structures are prohibited.
5. The display area shall be maintained in a clean condition. Empty storage racks and similar equipment shall not be stored within the display area.
6. White decorative picket fencing shall be placed around the perimeter of the display area in accordance with the photograph, dated May 26, 2010.
7. Safety cones shall be placed in the center median of the drive aisle as shown on the site plan dated May 26, 2010.

8. Signs shall not be permitted.
