

**RESOLUTION 2010-120**

**A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE BOARD TO ACCEPT PROPOSALS FROM ACRES GROUP AND BRICKMAN, AND TO ISSUE PURCHASE ORDERS TO THESE SERVICE PROVIDERS BASED ON THE PROPOSALS NOT TO EXCEED \$11,400 FOR THESE TWO PROVIDERS**

**WHEREAS**, Acres Group and Brickman provided snow and ice control service in 2008/09 as well as 2009/2010, and are familiar with the scope of work; and

**WHEREAS**, Acres Group submitted a proposal for snow removal of the streets in Shadow Creek; and

**WHEREAS**, Brickman has submitted a proposal for snow removal of the Grosse Pointe Circle cul-de-sacs; and

**WHEREAS**, a snow and ice control service proposal from James Martin Associates, Inc. is in the process of being submitted to the Village for acceptance, and will be presented for approval under a separate resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are budgeted in FY 10-11 street contractual services account 0102040-520630 for the snow removal of streets and cul-de-sacs as well as sidewalk snow removal.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**THAT**, the Village Board waives the competitive bidding process and the Village Manager is authorized to sign contracts, issue purchase orders to Acres Group for \$4,100 and Brickman for \$7,300, and to make payments in accordance with the proposals and contracts; and

**THAT**, the Finance Department is authorized to make payments to the above listed vendors in a total amount not to exceed \$11,400.




