

RESOLUTION 2010-132

A RESOLUTION FOR ACCEPTANCE AND APPROVAL OF THE COST ADJUSTMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS AND INTERNATIONAL PIPING SYSTEMS, INC. FOR MAINTENANCE SERVICES OF THE MONTHLY NOTIFACT MONITORING AT THE VILLAGE HALL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$504

WHEREAS, the contract dated April 4, 2005 between the Village of Vernon Hills and International Piping Systems, Inc.(IPS) allows for IPS to render for maintenance service for monthly Notifact Monitoring at the Village Hall; and

WHEREAS, according to paragraph (G) of the contract, contract adjustments will be made on the anniversary date of November 1; and will continue for twelve (12) months thereafter until October 31; and

WHEREAS, effective November 1, 2010, an adjustment will be made to the contract amount increasing the monthly fee for maintenance and monitoring from \$40 to \$42; and

WHEREAS, purchase order 2011-69 in the amount of \$600 was issued to International Piping Systems, Inc. for payment due for the Notifact Monitoring during the entire 2010-11 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in account 0102049-520600 if an increase to purchase order 2011-69 is needed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Village Manager is authorized to sign the Annual Contract Amount Adjustment to Service Contract with International Piping Services, Inc. for the period of November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011; and

THAT, the Finance Director is authorized to increase purchase order # 2011-69 to International Piping Systems, Inc. from account 0102049-520600 if necessary, and the Village Manager is authorized to make payments not to exceed \$504.


