

RESOLUTION 2009-115

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF \$4,119.88 FOR SENIOR ARTS PROGRAMS FROM ART-IN- ARCHITECTURE FEES CONTRIBUTED BY MARAVILLA AND THE PARK

WHEREAS, Ordinance 98-13 granted a special use permit for a congregate care facility which has been used by Maravilla and The Park; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 98-13 required the contribution of \$150,000 over ten years for Art-In-Architecture fees to be utilized for a senior arts program; and

WHEREAS, those funds have been collected are available to reimburse the cost of senior arts programs; and

WHEREAS, during FY2008-09, the Vernon Hills seniors paid the Milk Pail and Mid-America Charter Lines \$1,162.01 for attendance at that theatre;

WHEREAS, during FY2008-09, the Vernon Hills seniors paid the Fireside Dinner Theatre \$2,032.08 for attendance at that theatre;

WHEREAS, during FY2008-09, the Vernon Hills seniors paid the Lincolnshire Marriott Theatre \$925.00 for attendance at that theatre; and

WHEREAS, these three Theatre events costing \$4,119.88 are reimbursable from Art-In-Architecture fees in accordance with the uses defined in Ordinance 98-13.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT \$4,119.88 of Art-In-Architecture fees for Senior Arts programs can be reclassified from deferred revenue to a General Fund revenue for Senior Arts programs.




