

**RESOLUTION 2013-046**

**GRANTING APPROVAL OF THE CONSULTANT CONTRACT WITH  
ILLINOIS COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION NETWORK (ICCAN)  
FOR RENEWAL OF THE ELECTRIC AGGREGATION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Illinois allows municipalities the ability to aggregate the purchase of electricity for residences and small businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Consortium was formed to include Buffalo Grove, Wheeling, Arlington Heights, Long Grove, Lincolnshire, Palatine, and Vernon Hills for the purpose of securing electricity for our residences and small businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Consortium has agreed to retain the Illinois Community Choice Aggregation Network (ICCAN) as our consultant to secure continued purchase of aggregated electricity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois:

That the Village Manager is authorized to sign an agreement with Illinois Community Choice Aggregation Network (ICCAN) in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for services to secure continued purchase of aggregation services.


