

EXHIBIT C

UTILITIES AND FACILITIES IN BUTTERFIELD ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

- A. All privately owned utilities and facilities that would be under the pavement of Butterfield Road after the construction of (1) the Butterfield Road Improvements as required pursuant to Subsection 4.C of this Agreement and (2) the Butterfield Allanson and Butterfield/Huntington North Intersections as required pursuant to Subsection 5.B of this Agreement (the "Butterfield Road Pavement") shall be removed, relocated, or permanently abandoned in place. All privately owned utilities and facilities that would be within the Butterfield Road right-of-way as established pursuant to Subsection 4.A of this Agreement (the "Butterfield Road Right-of-Way") but not under the Butterfield Road Pavement shall be removed and relocated.
- B. All publicly owned utilities and facilities that would be under the Butterfield Road Pavement shall be removed and relocated.
- C. Unless otherwise approved by the Lake County Division of Transportation, all new utilities, relocated utilities, trails, paths, and sidewalks shall be located outside of the Butterfield Road Right-of-Way.
- D. All Butterfield Road utility crossings shall be perpendicular to the Butterfield Road Pavement.
- E. No open cuts of the Butterfield Road Pavement shall be permitted.
- F. No part of any berm shall be closer than 10 feet to the Butterfield Road Right-of-Way.
- G. The existing hedgerow vegetation along the east side of Butterfield Road shall be completely removed within nine months after the Agreement Date.
- H. - The County Engineer shall have the authority to modify the scope of the Butterfield Road utility and facility requirements set forth in this Exhibit upon the Village's written request and demonstration of good and sufficient cause.
