

RESOLUTION 2014-113

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF \$64,884.10
TO PAR DEVELOPMENT LLC OR ITS DESIGNEE FOR REIMBURSEMENT RELATED
TO THE IMPRELIS (DUPONT) CLAIM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, White Deer Run Golf Course is owned by the Village of Vernon Hills; and

WHEREAS, the Village hired Par Development to manage White Deer Run Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, Par Development utilized a DuPont pesticide product known as Imprelis in managing unwanted weeds, vines and grasses; and

WHEREAS, use of the Imprelis pesticide destroyed and damaged evergreen trees at White Deer Run where the product was utilized; and

WHEREAS, DuPont ceased manufacturing Imprelis and offered to reimburse the owners of damaged properties via a Claims Resolution Agreement; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Agreement, DuPont reimbursed the Village for damage, replacement and future maintenance of trees; and

WHEREAS, for the benefit of the golf course patrons, Par Development immediately replaced the damaged trees in order to maintain the golf course property and did not wait until the litigation was resolved; and

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board of Trustees deem it to be in the best interests of the Village to reimburse Par Development or its designee for the costs incurred by Par Development to replace the trees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois:

That the Village Manager is hereby authorized to make payments to reimburse Par Development or its designee in the amount of \$64,884.10, representing Ninety Percent (90%) of the total settlement of all matters relating to the Imprelis tree damage incurred at White Deer Run Golf Course.
