

RESOLUTION 2014-134

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF A JOINT AGREEMENT WITH THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF LANDSCAPING WITHIN ROUTE 21 MEDIANS ADJACENT TO WESTFIELD HAWTHORN SHOPPING CENTER

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills strives to maintain an aesthetically pleasing streetscape within IDOT's Rights of Way; and

WHEREAS, the Village received Federal ITEP funding to achieve this goal for two medians adjacent to the Westfield Hawthorn Shopping Center; and

WHEREAS, IDOT has scheduled a bid letting to make improvements along the Route 21 corridor; and

WHEREAS, IDOT has committed to have the ITEP landscaping and irrigation system installed as part of their resurfacing and concrete curb improvements; and

WHEREAS, the ITEP funding is 80% Federal and 20% local up to a maximum amount of \$101,463 with the Village being responsible for all costs for the landscaping and irrigation above this amount; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work has increased to incorporate the island north of Ring Drive, the addition of an irrigation system and 10% Construction Engineering to IDOT to manage the project; and

WHEREAS, the additional cost of these scope changes are \$75,162 based on IDOT's engineering estimates; and

WHEREAS, the Village understands the added value of the new scope of work and desires to move forward with the attached Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT the Village President is authorized to execute the Joint Agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation; and

THAT the Finance Director is authorized to make the necessary budget transfers.




