



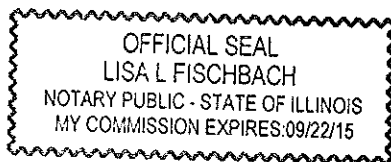

ORDINANCE 2015-001

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO
BE SURPLUS AND PROVIDING FOR
DISPOSAL**

WHEREAS, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities desire to dispose of such surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely.

1. 1984 Budd Trailer VIN 1BK10W929EE211130

SECTION II. The said surplus property is to be disposed of in an appropriate manner with a value of less than \$10.

SECTION III. The said surplus property is no longer usable and in an unusable condition for the Village of Vernon Hills with a value of less than \$10:

1. 1984 Trailer VIN: 1BK10W929EE211130 described in Section I (1) above, has been determined to be in poor condition and has no cash value.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION VII. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2015-001.
