





ORDINANCE NO. 2017-033

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, APPENDIX C ZONING, ARTICLE 21 ADMINISTRATION, SECTION 21.3 THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*"the Village"*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Compiled Statutes require that Cities and Villages in the State of Illinois have a Plan Commission in order to perform required services in the review and approval of Planning and Zoning Issues within said municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Village has created a Planning and Zoning Commission to serve in this capacity; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees (*"Village Board"*) has found it necessary to establish certain rates of compensation for members serving on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: CODE OF ORDINANCES MODIFIED: Appendix C Zoning, Article 21, Administration, Section 21.3 - The Planning and Zoning Commission is hereby repealed and in its place the follow is approved to read:

Section 21.3.1. Commission. The planning and zoning commission of the Village of Vernon Hills shall consist of seven members, all who shall be residents of the village, but not employees of the village. Each member shall be appointed by the village president with the advice and consent of the board of trustees. One of the members of said commission shall be appointed by the president as chairman, for a term of four years and shall hold his office as chairman until his successor is appointed. The remaining members shall be appointed for terms of four years. This commission may elect its own officers other than the chair and adopt its own rules regarding procedure. The village president shall have power to remove any member of said commission with the advice and consent of the village board. Vacancies in said commission shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place for the appointment of such member has become vacant in the manner herein provided.

Terms for all members shall be for four years commencing on January 1, 2006.

21.3.2. Compensation. Members of the planning and zoning commission shall be compensated for attendance at each meeting. The rate of compensation shall be \$75 per meeting for the chairman of the commission and \$50 per meeting for all other members of the commission.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY: In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable form the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3: REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of May 1, 2017.

SECTION 5: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2017-033.




