



ORDINANCE NO. 2017-043**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES OVER \$20,000 TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE WITHIN THE FY2017-18 BUDGET YEAR NOT TO EXCEED \$58,000**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*"the Village"*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills has an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) for preventative maintenance and repairs to the traffic signals on State highways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board approved the FY2017-18 budget which delineates funds for preventative maintenance and repairs for the state highway signal maintenance in account (0102040-520090); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Libertyville shares in the cost and reimburses the Village for maintenance of traffic signals at Rt. 21 at Gregg's Parkway/North Artaius Drive, South Artaius/Lowes Entrance, and North Hollister Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, Lowe's Home Center shares in the cost and reimburses the Village for the cost for maintenance of the traffic signal at Rt. 21 and South Artaius/Lowes Entrance; and

**WHEREAS**, American Hotel Register reimburses the Village for the total cost for maintenance of the traffic signal at Rt. 21 and American Hotel Register; and

**WHEREAS**, all expenditures and purchases over \$20,000 require Board of Trustees approval.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is authorized to execute payments to the Illinois Department of Transportation for traffic signal maintenance throughout the FY2017-18 budget year in an amount not to exceed \$58,000; and

THAT, the Finance Director is authorized to apply re-imbusement monies received from the mentioned outside entities to account (0102040-520090), and increase the FY2017-18 purchase order to the Illinois Department of Transportation as necessary.

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2017-043.




