



ORDINANCE NO. 2017-078**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES TO COUNTRYSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR THE NET SURPLUS OF DISPATCH SERVICES REVENUES FROM THE VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE AND E-911 FEES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,067

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois ("*the Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Countryside Fire Protection District operate a joint-dispatch center; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Countryside Fire Protection District have entered into a contractual agreement with the Village of Libertyville to provide police and fire dispatch services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the contract, the Village received \$670,397 in FY 2016-17 from the Village of Libertyville for the operation of the dispatch center; and

WHEREAS, the Village spent \$562,056 in FY2016-17 for costs associated with the operations related to the Village of Libertyville dispatch services; and

WHEREAS, the surplus of revenues versus expenses for providing service to the Village of Libertyville is projected to be \$108,341 for FY 2016-17; and

WHEREAS, the Village's E-911 revenues versus expenses over the twelve month period beginning May 1, 2016 was a deficit of (\$19,407); and

WHEREAS, the net of the Village of Libertyville surplus and the Village's deficit equals \$88,934, which will be distributed to the Village at 69.6% of the total surplus and Countryside Fire Protection District at 30.4% of the surplus; and

WHEREAS, Countryside Fire Protection District's share of the surplus for FY2016-17 is calculated to be \$27,067; and

WHEREAS, expenditures over \$20,000 require Board of Trustees approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT: The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment to Countryside Fire Protection District for surplus sharing from account 0803032-520540 in an amount not to exceed \$27,067 and is further authorized to immediately release payment to Countryside Fire Protection District for surplus sharing prior to appearing on the invoice approval list.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2017-078.




