





ORDINANCE NO. 2017-089**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADES AT ROUTE 21 & CORPORATE WOODS PARKWAY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED OF \$1,150

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills has an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) for preventative maintenance and repairs to the traffic signals on State highways; and

WHEREAS, the Master Agreement for the traffic signal maintenance at Corporate Woods and Route 21 obligates the Village of Vernon Hills to participate in the modernization and upgrades to said signal; and

WHEREAS, IDOT is performing upgrades to Pedestrian Signals throughout District 1 in multiple Counties which includes the Route 21 and Corporate Woods Parkway intersection; and

WHEREAS, IDOT has shared the attached agreement that obligates the Village to pay 10% of the estimated \$11,500 cost for construction and engineering; and

WHEREAS, the Village agrees to financially participate in the improvements consistent with the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT: The Village President and Clerk are authorized to execute the referenced agreement and the Finance Director is authorized to execute payments to the Illinois Department of Transportation for traffic signal upgrades in an amount not to exceed \$1,150; and

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2017-089.


