

**ORDINANCE 2017-096**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2017 CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLE FROM MILES CHEVROLET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$37,135 AND DECLARING ONE (1) 2012 CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLE AS SURPLUS AND HAVING LITTLE VALUE TO DISPOSE OF IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department's 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe Pursuit Vehicle ("PD102-12"), VIN 1GNLC2E00CR237524 sustained major damage in an accident on July 16, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, this vehicle is scheduled to be replaced within the current 2017/2018 budget year; and

**WHEREAS**, a damage estimate was provided by IPMG in the amount of \$8,955.28 (with a possibility of additional damage uncovered during disassembly); and

**WHEREAS**, IPMG will issue a check to the Village in the amount of \$7,955.28 (the amount of the damages less our \$1,000 deductible); and

**WHEREAS**, staff had determined that it is in the best interest of the Village not to repair this vehicle and to apply funds from IPMG to purchase a replacement vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, PD102-12 is hereby declared surplus in accordance with State Statutes and shall be disposed of in an appropriate manner; and

**WHEREAS**, Miles Chevrolet, 150 W. Pershing Road, Decatur, IL is an authorized Chevrolet dealership that has been selected through a competitive bidding process to provide motor vehicles to municipalities participating in the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Program Contract #PSD4018343 at the rate specified in the bid (contract); and

**WHEREAS**, Miles Chevrolet has said 2017 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit vehicle in stock and available for immediate delivery; and

**WHEREAS**, all purchases over \$20,000 require Board of Trustee approval.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION FOR PURCHASE:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Miles Chevrolet to commit the Village to purchase one (1) 2017 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit vehicle; and

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION OF DISPOSAL:** The Public Works Director is hereby authorized to dispose of PD102-12, a 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe pursuit vehicle, in an appropriate manner; and

**SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is authorized to process a purchase order to Miles Chevrolet in the amount of \$37,135, and is authorized to release the payment prior to the payment appearing on the Invoice Approval Report; and

**SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law; and

**SECTION 5: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This ordinance shall be known as ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-096.
