

RESOLUTION 2018-024

A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO OPERATE FOUR OUTDOOR SPECIAL EVENTS FOR BGV MOTORSPORTS LOCATED AT 280 HAWTHORN VILLAGE COMMONS

WHEREAS, representatives of BGV Motorsports in cooperation with Bo-Bo's Gyros, 280 Hawthorn Village Commons has submitted an Outdoor Establishment permit application and plan for authorization to operate four outdoor special events; and

WHEREAS, the property, as described herein is located within the B-1, General Business District; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code authorizes the Village Board to approve outdoor uses within the B-1 General Business District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, having reviewed and considered the request for the outdoor special events at their Committee of the Whole meeting on April 17, 2018, found that the application and plan sufficiently comply with Section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code and which, in its judgment, would justify it in recommending approval of the Outdoor special event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, that the Village of Vernon Hills will allow BGV Motorsports in cooperation with Bo-Bo's Gyros to operate four outdoor special events, conditioned upon:

1. The classic car show will take place on Sunday, July 15, 2018. The hours of operation will be 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
2. The three Cruise nights will take place on Tuesday, June 5, July 3 and August 7, 2018. The hours of operation of each event would be 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM. Approval is subject to continued landlord permission.
3. Compliance with the application and site plans dated April 11, 2018.
4. Garbage receptacles shall be provided and the general vicinity shall be cleaned immediately following each event.
