

**RESOLUTION 2018-054**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO OPERATE AN OUTDOOR SPECIAL EVENT FOR  
MELLODY FARM LOCATED AT 849 MILWAUKEE AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, Victoria Jacobson, representing Melody Farm, 849 Milwaukee Avenue has submitted an Outdoor Establishment permit application and plan for authorization to operate a special event; and

**WHEREAS**, the property, as described herein is located within the B-1, General Business District; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code authorizes the Village Board to approve outdoor uses within the B-1 General Business District; and.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, at their meeting on October 2, 2018 having reviewed and considered the request for an outdoor special event, found that the application and plan sufficiently comply with Section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code and which, in its judgment, would justify it in recommending approval of the outdoor special event.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, that the Village of Vernon Hills will allow Melody Farm to operate an outdoor special event, conditioned upon:

1. The special event will take place from Sunday, October 7, 2018.
2. The permitted hours of operation shall be 1:00 PM to 4: PM.
3. The Village reserves the right to require the hiring of two (2) off duty Vernon Hills police officers to be on site during the operating hours of the event. Melody Farm shall be responsible to pay the cost of the officers at a rate determined by the Village.
4. Compliance with the application and site plan dated September 21, 2018.
5. Garbage receptacles shall be provided and the general vicinity shall be cleaned immediately following the event.
