

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS  
ORDINANCE 2020-095**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS  
AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALE BY PUBLIC OR INTERNET AUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined according to the state statutes and Village ordinances by the corporate authorities of the Village of Vernon Hills that there exist certain surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities desire to sell such surplus property by public or internet auction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION I.** The following property the Village of Vernon Hills is found and declared to be surplus namely

1. 2001 Ford Windstar VIN: 2FMDA50401BB70739
2. 2006 Ford Crown Victoria VIN: 2FAHP71W76X114216
3. 2006 Ford F350 Super Duty 4WD VIN: 1FTWF31Y46ED64724
4. 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe VIN: 1GNLC2E03CR227375
5. 2007 Chevrolet Impala VIN: 2G1WS55R179356829
6. 2009 Ford Crown Victoria VIN: 2FAHP71V39X145734
7. Two pallets of filters and obsolete parts which are no longer of any use to the Village and hold little to no value.

**SECTION II.** The said surplus property is to be sold through a public or internet auction.

**SECTION III.** The said surplus property shall individually be withdrawn from the sale at the public or internet auction unless the following minimum sum shall be bid for said property:

1. 2001 Ford Windstar VIN: 2FMDA50401BB70739 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1200.00
2. 2006 Ford Crown Victoria VIN: 2FAHP71W76X114216 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$1000.00

3. 2006 Ford F350 Super Duty 4WD VIN: 1FTWF31Y46ED64724 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$4000.00
4. 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe VIN: 1GNLC2E03CR227375 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$5000.00
5. 2007 Chevrolet Impala VIN: 2G1WS55R179356829 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$2500.00
6. 2009 Ford Crown Victoria VIN: 2FAHP71V39X145734 described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$2000.00
7. Two pallets of filters and obsolete parts described in Section I (1) above, the minimum acceptable sum shall be \$50.00

**SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY.** In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found invalid and valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several application, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

**SECTION V. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Vernon Hills prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION VII. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.

**SECTION VIII. ORDINANCE NUMBER.** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2020-095.




