### **Garbage Service, Recycling, Yardwaste - Call Advanced Disposal at (847) 623-3870 to set up service or address an issue.**

- Residential garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection is serviced by Advanced Disposal.
- Yard waste stickers can be purchased at participating retailers and at the Village Hall - \$2.00 each, cash or check only.
- Please note that all trash, garbage and yard waste containers must be stored out of public view except on the date of pick up.
- You must contact Advanced Disposal for special pickups if the items are large or do not get picked up on the regular route. Do not place items in the parkway until the day of pick up.

**Voter Registration and Absentee Voting**
