



PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The Village's 2021 Road Rehabilitation Project Improvements will be performed on the following streets:

- Cherry Valley Road from Lakeside Drive to Oakwood Road
- Cherry Valley Road between Oakwood Road and Westmoreland Drive
- Richard Court
- Court of Ash
- Court of Elm
- Greenbrier Lane
- Lakeside Drive, between Westmoreland Drive and Cherry Valley Road
- Westmoreland Drive between Lakeside Drive and Cherry Valley Road
- Bloomfield Court in the Grosse Pointe Circle subdivision

PHASE 1 SCOPE OF WORK

Concrete rehabilitation work will include curb/gutter removal and replacement, sidewalk removal and replacement, and drainage structure improvements.

During this phase of construction homeowners are asked not to park on the streets. Homeowners whose driveway access may be interrupted, will be allowed to park overnight on the street. Arrangements have been made with the Police Department to allow overnight street parking during **Phase 1** construction only.

Please do not park in front of fire hydrants, at corners or blocking sidewalks and driveways, violators will be ticketed.

Please relocate all vehicles off the streets where barricades are present by 7:00 am to allow work to be completed on schedule.

PHASE 2 SCOPE OF WORK

Asphalt pavement surface milling, asphalt patching, asphalt pavement cleaning and preparation, asphalt pavement prime (oil), asphalt pavement overlay and landscape restoration work.

Vehicles will not be permitted to be parked on any street during this construction phase. Overnight street parking is not allowed.

This project is tentatively scheduled to begin May 3, 2021 and be substantially completed by early July 2021.

Delays can be expected, please observe construction signs and direction of any workers or flag persons present.

Homeowners with pet fences and irrigation systems are asked to contact us as soon as possible so that we can avoid damage. Residents with other concerns should also contact us so that arrangements can be made.

Mail delivery and trash pickup will continue as scheduled. Some delays may occur, and pickup times may be adjusted to accommodate the construction.
