

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2022-025**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY RECOVERED AND/OR
TAKEN IN BY THE VERNON HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT DURING CALENDAR YEARS
2022 AND 2023 PURSUANT TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY ACT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills is a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and is exercising its home rule authority in enacting this Ordinance ;
and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills operates a Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Village of Vernon Hills Police Department comes into possession of lost, stolen or mislaid property from time to time including varying types a personal property including cell phones, bicycles, and other assorted items ; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Law Enforcement Disposition Of Property Act, 765 ILCS 1030/1 *et seq.* governs the disposition of property and the manner in method in which a police organization may dispose of property it acquires; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills Police Department desires an appropriate and efficient means of disposing of property while providing full disclosure and transparency to the Village Board.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 2: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-025.

SECTION 3: DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY The Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Chief of Police, or his or her designee, to dispose of property during the remainder of the calendar year 2022 and throughout calendar year 2023 in the manner prescribed by Vernon Hills Ordinance Number 2018-147 and the Illinois Law Enforcement Disposition of Property Act, 765 ILCS 1030/1 *et seq.* and to make monthly and annual reports to the Board of Trustees as required there under.




