

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
RESOLUTION 2022-014**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO OPERATE AN OUTDOOR SPECIAL EVENT FOR
HAWTHORN MALL LOCATED AT 122 HAWTHORN CENTER**

WHEREAS, Andrew Casillas, in cooperation with Hawthorn Mall, 122 Hawthorn Center has submitted an Outdoor Establishment permit application and plan for authorization to operate six (6) outdoor classic car events; and

WHEREAS, section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code authorizes the Village Board to approve outdoor uses within the B-1, General Business District.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, at their meeting on April 19, 2022 having reviewed and considered the request for six (6) outdoor classic car events, found that the application and plan sufficiently comply with section 13.7.6 of the Zoning Code and which, in its judgment, would justify it in recommending approval of the events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Vernon Hills, Lake County, Illinois, that the Village of Vernon Hills will allow Hawthorn Mall to operate six (6) outdoor classic car events, conditioned upon:

1. The classic car shows will take place on Sunday, May 15, June 12, July 17, August 7, September 18 and October 16. The hours of operation will be 9:00 to 11:00 am; and
2. Compliance with the application and site plans dated April 4, 2022; and
3. Garbage receptacles shall be provided and the general vicinity shall be cleaned immediately following each day of the event; and
4. The Vernon Hills Police Department reserves the right to require police officers on site during the operating hours of the Event. North Suburban Cars and Coffee shall be responsible to pay the cost of the officers at a rate determined by the Village.


