**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-114, AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE OF EXPENDITURES FROM \$65,901 TO \$66,107 TO CURRIE MOTORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2022 FORD F250 PICK-UP TRUCKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are delineated in FY 2021-2022 budget account (2102040-540030) for vehicle purchases; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board approved Ordinance 2021-114 authorizing the purchase of two (2) 2022 Ford F250 Pick-Up trucks for a not to exceed amount of \$65,901.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the staff ordered said trucks through Currie Motors, and opted to have the pick-up bed/box removed from one of the trucks for a cost-savings of \$206; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle manufacturer reached out stating that they are unable to manufacture the vehicle without the pick-up bed/box; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has decided to proceed with the purchase of the one truck with the pick-up bed/box included for an additional cost of \$206; and

**WHEREAS**, staff is requesting authorization to purchase said trucks to include the addition of a pick-up bed/box which will increase the not to exceed amount of \$65,901 an additional \$206; and

**WHEREAS**, the additional \$206 is available within FY2021-2022 budget account (2102040-540030).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1: EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Currie Motors to commit the Village to purchase two (2) 2022 Ford F250 pick-up trucks in an amount not to exceed \$66,107; and

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION AND RELEASE OF PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is authorized to increase FY2022 purchase order #1202 from \$32,281 to \$32,487 for the purchase of one Ford F250 pick-up truck, and to make payment to Currie Motors in an amount not to exceed \$66,107 for the purchase of two (2) 2022 Ford F250 Pick-up trucks.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-045.


