ORDINANCE 2022-066

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES OVER \$25,000 TO MORTON SALT INC. TO FURNISH BULK ROCK SALT UNDER THE FIRST YEAR OF THE LAKE COUNTY JOINT BID FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$112,000**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (*“the Village”*) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village is under its first year of the Lake County Joint Bid for the purchase of 1,600 tons of Bulk Road Salt at a rate of \$79.27 per ton for the 2022 and 2023 Winter seasons with Morton Salt Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has the ability to purchase a minimum of 80% (1,280 tons) up to 120% (1,920 tons) at the \$79.27 per ton rate, or 121% (1,936 tons) up to 150% (2,400 tons) at a rate of \$89.27 per ton based on the 1,600 tons contracted; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board approved \$112,000 within the FY2022-2023 budget which delineates funds for the purchase of said salt within budget account (0102053-530090); and

**WHEREAS**, the consolidated purchases throughout the budget year of over \$25,000 require Board of Trustee approval.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT:** The Finance Director is authorized to execute payments to Morton Salt Inc. for the purchase of Bulk Road Salt for an amount not to exceed \$112,000.

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

**SECTION 3: ORDINANCE NUMBER:** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-066.


