

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES TO
FACTORY CLEANING EQUIPMENT, INC. (FCE) FOR THE PURCHASE OF
ONE (1) NEW FACTORY CAT RIDER SWEEPER FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$18,000**

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills, County of Lake, State of Illinois (“the Village”) is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vernon Hills maintains several municipal buildings; including the Public Works building; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Dept. stores all vehicles and equipment inside the heated garage that is attached to the main building; and

WHEREAS, the concrete floor of the garage requires routine sweeping and power washing due to the amount of dust, mud, oil, and salt that accumulates from the vehicles and equipment being driven outside; and

WHEREAS, the garage is also used to host special events such as the SWALCO Reuse-A-Shoe Collection, Public Works Open House, and employee luncheons; and

WHEREAS, Staff currently hand-sweeps the garage floor which can involve the labor of 3-4 staff members sweeping at a time amongst an unhealthy cloud of dust; and

WHEREAS, to make the sweeping process more efficient and cost-effective, Staff began researching commercial ride-on sweepers manufactured for the purpose of cleaning indoor concrete floors; and

WHEREAS, Staff found that Factory Cleaning Equipment, Inc. (FCE) specializes in the type of sweeper that fits the department’s needs; and that they are a sole source within the region to manufacture said type of sweeper; and

WHEREAS, FCE provided a quote for one (1) New Factory Cat Model TR Rider Sweeper for the amount of \$17,994; and

WHEREAS, Staff seeks approval to purchase one (1) New Factory Cat Model TR Rider Sweeper for the amount of \$17,994; and

WHEREAS, the funds to purchase said sweeper will be found within the FY2023 Equipment Replacement Fund account (2102040-460520).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute all documents required with Factory Cleaning Equipment, Inc. to purchase one (1) New Factory Cat Model TR Rider Sweeper for an amount not to exceed \$18,000.

SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE OF PAYMENT:

The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payments to Factory Cleaning Equipment, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$18,000.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.


SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-073.


