

**VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS
ORDINANCE 2022-074**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE AT WHICH GROUPS AND
ORGANIZATIONS ARE TO REIMBURSE THE VILLAGE FOR SPECIAL POLICE
SERVICES EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2022**

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, Lake County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule municipality, pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village’s Police Department has, from time to time, provided special police services, such as traffic direction, special protections and other services to ensure the safety of the Village’s residents and businesses, and to support various events and activities within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2003-98 established that the Police Department shall bill for such special police services; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Illinois FOP Labor Council have agreed that the billing rate for these special police services shall equal to one-and-one-half the hourly rate of a top-pay patrol officer; and

WHEREAS, the billing rates for special police services have been established as follows:

- May 1, 2022 – April 30, 2023: \$80.64 per hour
- May 1, 2023 – April 30, 2024: \$83.27 per hour
- May 1, 2024 – April 30, 2025: \$85.76 per hour
- May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026: \$88.12 per hour

WHEREAS, the Village is empowered to provide and seek reimbursement for these special police services, pursuant to its home rule powers and authority provided by Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: DETAIL RATE TO CHARGE GROUPS AND ORGANIZATIONS:

The Village Board has determined the provision of special police services will be billed at the rate of time and one-half of top patrol officer hourly pay, and at double that rate on holidays beginning May 1, 2022.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.

SECTION 3: ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES SUPERCEDED: All prior ordinances or resolutions setting the rate for special police services by the Vernon Hills Police Department shall be null and void, and shall be superseded by the terms of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: ORDINANCE NUMBER: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 2022-074.


