

RESOLUTION 2011-050

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2010-129 INCREASING PURCHASE ORDER 2011-2418 TO JAMES MARTIN ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR SNOW REMOVAL OF 106 CUL-DE-SACS AND THE METRA STATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,159.50

WHEREAS, James Martin Associates, Inc. submitted a proposal for snow removal of 106 cul-de-sacs, and plowing and sidewalk snow removal of the Metra Station Parking Complex for the 2010-11 Winter Season; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2010-129 was approved on October 19, 2010 authorizing the Village Manager to sign a contract with James Martin Associates, Inc., and to issue a purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$73,500; and

WHEREAS, The Village agreed to pay James Martin Associates, Inc. a guaranteed pre-paid minimum of \$39,140 for the 106 cul-de-sacs and \$24,650 for the Metra Station totaling \$63,790; and

WHEREAS, the cost for snow removal within the cul-de-sacs and Metra Station went above the pre-paid guaranteed minimums as a result of the February 2, 2011 "Blizzard;" and additional snowfalls throughout the months of February and March that totaled \$42,619.50; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$24,159.50 is needed to pay James Martin Associates for their snow removal services within the cul-de-sacs during the months of February and March; and

WHEREAS, the funds to increase Purchase Order 2011-2418 are available in account 0102040-520630.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VERNON HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

THAT, the Village Board authorizes the Finance Director to increase Purchase Order 2011-2418 to James Martin Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$24,159.50, and to make payments.




